Workshop overview:

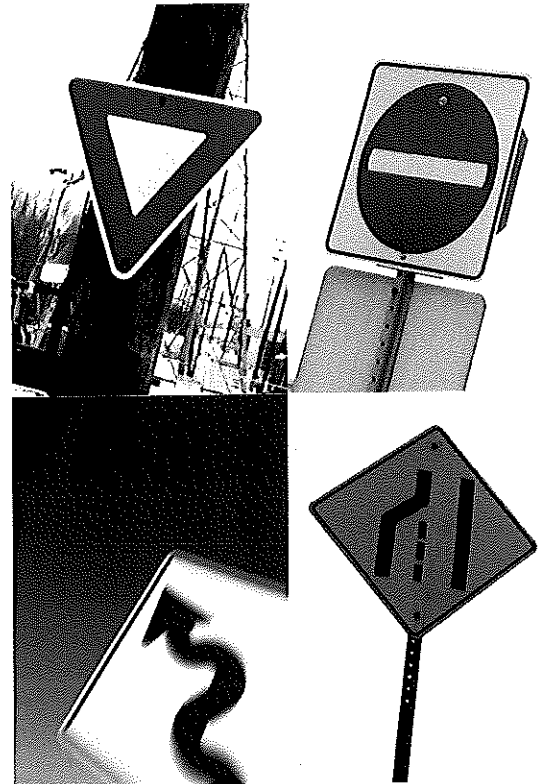
