

## Managing Floodplain Development through the NFIP

\*Restricted Enrollment \*

**March 23-27, 2015**



### Course Description:

This course is designed to provide an organized training opportunity for local officials responsible for administering their local floodplain management ordinance. The course will focus on the NFIP and concepts of floodplain management, maps and studies, ordinance administration, and the relationship between floodplain management and flood insurance. Enrollment is by invitation only.

### Course Objectives:

By the end of the basic course, participants will be able to:

- Provide outreach to citizens and officials to help them make informed decisions.
- Apply NFIP floodplain criteria/management regulations.
- Identify appropriate Letters of Map Change (LOMCs) for specific circumstances and describe the LOMC process.
- Explain how building codes relate to floodplain management.
- Identify and assemble a basic floodplain permit.
- Provide technical assistance and creative solutions to mitigate flood hazards.
- Explain basic concepts of flood insurance rating as related to new development and floodplain management.
- Develop/review and complete an elevation certificate and other certificates needed for floodplain management purposes.
